## **Organization and Time Management are KEY**

- --keep a centralized calendar; write things down, plan

## It Isn't How Hard You Work, But How Smart You Work

- --learn to study efficiently
- --take extra pains to understand assignments
- --your reading and writing process IS your learning process

## **Attitude is Aptitude**

## **Set Goals**

- --goals provide direction and purpose, so set goals for yourself
