How can you help readers see the RELEVANCE or importance of this fact to the context or situation? <u>How</u> and <u>why</u> does this evidence support your claim? <u>Give examples.</u></p>	<p><u>Possible Outcome or Result:</u></p> <p>What might happen if we use this evidence to make a decision about how we'll think, act, or believe?</p>	<p><u>Authorizing:</u></p> <p>Why is this source so CREDIBLE? Why should we pay attention?</p>
