

About the WTI

SAC Writing & Thinking Institute (WTI) promotes the use of writing as an instructional tool for learning and critical thinking across the curriculum at San Antonio College. The WTI is a year-long professional development course for faculty to advance their skills for using writing effectively to teach course content.





What You Will Learn

During this course, faculty will share best practices with their colleagues. Topics of the course include:

- principles of write-to-learn
- approaches to using informal and formal writing assignments
- strategies for using writing to engage students in critical thinking and deep learning
- elements of effective writing assignment design.

Your Commitment as a WTI Fellow

The WTI course involves attending 30 hours of professional development over two semesters

- 15 hours in Fall and Spring over four Friday afternoon sessions
- Friday sessions always involve lunch

Participants agree to

- develop and try in their classroom two informal, exploratory write-to-learn assignments in the Fall, and one informal, exploratory and one formal assignment in the Spring
- share one of these classroom writing assignments at the WTI Conference
- compile all their deliverables in an ePortfolio at the end of the Institute
